ENROLLMENT PROCESS:

Completion of this application does not secure enrollment. We will follow up by Monday June 2 about the status of your application.

Tuition is \$100 per child. **NO PAYMENT IS NECESSARY AT THIS TIME**.

Upon being accepted to the program, we will collect payment via cash, check, or online through our donation portal (choose Waterdogs 2025 Membership). Scholarships available.



CLASSES:

- Monday Friday, July 21 August 1 at Hearts Desire Beach, 1100 Pierce Point Rd., Inverness CA
- All students must be on time for class. Allow 15 minutes to park and change into swim gear. Class time will be assigned upon acceptance to the program since groups will be based on skill level and age.

 - o 2:20 2:50pm
- All children must be accompanied by an adult to all swimming classes. Each child must have a designated adult that is watching them at all times, especially during class.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

- A limited number of scholarships are available for West Marin residents. Please contact WMCS for a scholarship application form.
- Please consider donating to sponsor a child through the Waterdogs' Scholarship Fund.
- You will be asked about your need for a scholarship and willingness to donate once your child is accepted to the program.

POOL TESTING:

- The final testing will be Wednesday July 30 and Thursday 31 at a pool in West Marin (address TBA) during your child's regular class time. If you know of a local pool we can use, please contact us! Late arrivals will not be tested.
- An adult must accompany the child. No additional children will be allowed.

FINAL DAY OF WATERDOGS AUGUST 1:

Level 1	Must be at least 6 years old, no swimming prerequisites. Orientation to the		
Intro. to Water Skills	aquatic environment. Participants acquire basic aquatic skills and learn how to be safe around the water.

Level 2	Prerequisites for this level are that swimmers can independently:		
	Glide on front for at least 2 body lengths.		
Fundamental	Roll to a back float for 5 seconds.		
Aquatic Skills	Recover to a vertical position without assistance.		
	Enter and exit the water.		
Level 3	Prerequisites for this level are that swimmers can independently:		
	Execute all skills described in Level 2.		
Stoke	Tread or float for at least 15 seconds then swim on front and/or back for		
Development	5 body lengths.		
	Back float for 15 seconds, roll to front, then recover to a vertical position.		
	Push off wall and swim using combined arm and leg actions on front for 5		
	body lengths, roll to back, float for 15 seconds, roll to front, then		
	continue swimming for at least 5 body lengths.		
Level 4	Prerequisites for this level are that swimmers can independently:		
Level 4	Execute all skills described in Level 2 and 3.		
Stroke	Jump into deep water, recover to the surface, maintain position by		
Improvement	treading or floating for 1 minute, rotate one complete turn, then swim		
	front crawl (freestyle) or elementary backstroke for 25 yards.		
	Push off the wall in a streamlined position, then swim front crawl		
	(freestyle) for 15 yards, change position and direction as necessary, then		
	swim elementary backstroke for 15 yards.
